ACT vs. SAT Score Comparison

If you've taken both the SAT and ACT or PSAT/PACT, you can compare your scores to find out which test you should concentrate on re-taking. For example: if you scored a 32 on the ACT and a 1390 on the SAT it means you scored better on the ACT and should proceed with only retaking the ACT trying to improve your score.
